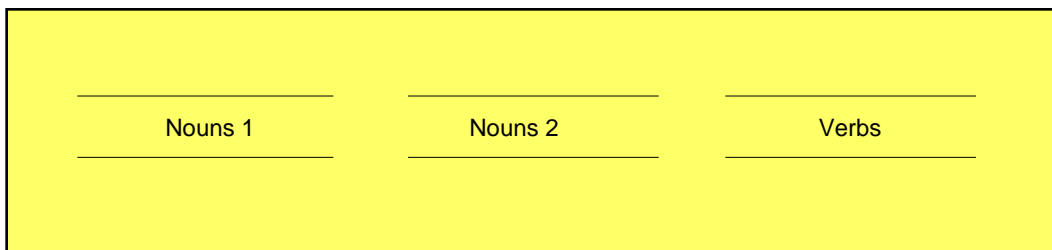

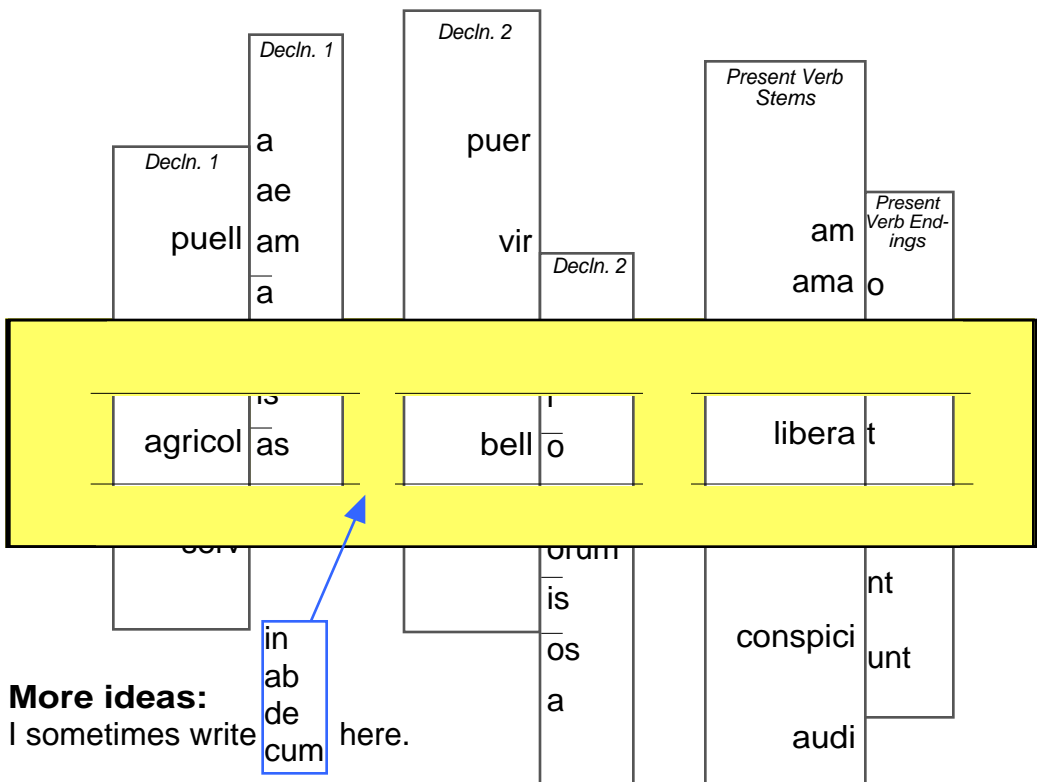

## The finished product.

Activities:

- \* *Dictation*--Say a sentence and students construct it.
- \* *Translation*-- Say a sentence in English and students construct the Latin version.
- \* *Hidden ending*-- Make a sentence. Cover one of the endings and challenge the students to complete it.
- \* *Fun*-- challenge students to construct the most bizarre sentence they can.

## Points:

Better to have fewer words than too many. The slide become unruly-- just like students!

Here I've separated the endings from the stems, but you may want a slide with all ablatives of various declensions, or datives or ...whatever!
